





By letter dated June 15, 1954, Mr. George J. Gould, Director, Security Division, Department of Defense, requested an investigation of Dr. Bronk for the period from 1947 to the present time. There is attached a summary reflecting the results of the inquiries made by this Bureau concerning Dr. Bronk. There are also attached four reports of an investigation conducted by this Bureau in 1947 concerning Dr. Bronk at the request of another Government agency. Copies of these reports have previously been furnished to the Department of Defense and a copy of the summary has been furnished to the Honorable Charles E. Wilson. Copies of these reports and a copy of the summary have also been furnished the Honorable Sherman Adams.

In addition, a copy of this summary is also being furnished to Admiral Lewis L. Strauss of the Atomic inergy Commission inasmuch as the investigation disclosed that Reports of the 1947 investigation have previously been Turnished to the Atomic Energy Commission.

The records of another Government agency were not aveilable for review during the course of this investigation. As soon as this information has been made available, you will be advised.

I wish to advise that the investigation of Dr. Bronk covered inquiries as to his character, loyalty, general standing and ability, but no inquiries were made as to the sources of his income.

Dr. Bronk serves as trustee of Johns Hopkins University, Baltimore, Maryland, and The Rockefeller Institute. He is also a member of the National Selective Service Scientific_Advisory Group; a consultant to the Mational Science Foundation and the President's Science Advisory Committee; and a trustee of the American Freedom from Hunger Foundation, Incorporated Dr. Bronk was a consultant to the Agency for International Development from December, 1961, to May, 1963. He also served as a consultant with the Department of Defense in conjunction with his position as President of the Mational Academy of Sciences. After three successive four-year terms, Dr. Bronk voluntarily resigned as President of the Mational Academy of Sciences in 1962.

In 1964 he was the recipient of the Medal of Freedom from President Johnson and the Public Welfare Medal of the National Academy of Sciences. He is a member of numerous scientific organizations in the United States and is a Foreign Associate of the Royal Society of London for the Advancement of Science and the scientific academies of France, Denmark, Sweden, Brazil and the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics.
